The competition will be organised and run in accordance with the Classification Regulations, Para-Badminton Regulations and Laws of Badminton. The below are <u>a few reminders</u> of important regulations. Please see the BWF website for the full details.

Minimum Entries	If entries are not sufficient for a group draw followed by a knock-out draw, a single group format shall apply.	
Combinations	If there are less than four (4) entries or less than three (3) represented countries in a particular event, the events may be combined in accordance with the Para-Badminton Competition Regulation 5.1.5.1 (Appendix 14, General Competition Regulations) – see www.bwfbadminton.org	
Withdrawals	Please inform the Tournament Organiser about any withdrawals as soon as possible - at least 7 days prior to the event. Any withdrawal must be accompanied by the appropriate certification.	

Conditions of play	The tournament will be played in accordance with BWF Laws of Badminton and Para-Badminton Competition Regulations – see the BWF website www.bwfbadminton.org
Readiness to Play	All events will be run on a strict time scale. Competitors must be ready to play 30 minutes before the scheduled match time. If players are not ready to play at the scheduled time they will be disqualified.
	Any changes to the schedule of play will be announced by the Referee.
Warm-up / practicing	On court, warm up time is limited to a maximum of 3 minutes.
Entry	Entries can only be accepted on the Official Entry Form.
