You will require a username and password to submit your entries and this can be obtained from the BWF. Please contact Mr. Shan at <u>s.ramachandran@bwfbadminton.org</u>. The online entry page will close immediately on the entries closing date at 23:59 hours BWF Headquarters time (+08:00h GMT) and you are required to submit the entries on time. Late entries will not be accepted.

No entry forms are required by Member Association. All entries must be submitted online only.

After the closing date, the BWF Online Entry System will send notification to all participating Member Associations confirming receipt of final entries. Receipt of this notification is the conclusive evidence of receipt of entries before the deadline. The Member Associations should contact BWF immediately if such notice is not received by the Wednesday (next day of the entries closing date) by noon BWF Headquarters time (+08.00h GMT) following close of entries. If no objection is received by BWF by Thursday (second day after the entries closing day) 23.59 hours BWF Headquarters time (+08.00h GMT) following the close of entries, the entries shall be deemed to be correct. No complaints / objections shall be entertained after this point.

Video Recording:

- Written authorisation in form of a sticker for the use of any video equipment only by coaches of the participating national associations must be obtained in advance from the Tournament Office. They must be clearly displayed on the cameras. Security will confiscate cameras set up in incorrect positions or without a pass.
- The recording can be done for such approved cameras from a limited number of predesignated positions.

Any costs incurred for diagnosis, consultancy, medical treatment (including any form of surgical procedure) and / or hospitalisation shall be borne by the Member Association of the player / official concerned.

Please ensure that your players & team officials possess the requisite insurance coverage to meet current requirements.

Players clothing Advertisement

MANDATORY CLOTHING REGULATIONS

- 1. Name of player is MANDATORY from the first day of the event.
- 2. From Quarter Finals onwards, doubles partners must wear clothing of the same colour.
- **3**. From Quarter Finals onwards, opposing players must wear clothing of significantly different colours.
- 4. A maximum of one advertisement may appear on each of the following locations; left sleeve, right sleeve, left shoulder, right shoulder, left collar, right collar, right chest, left chest and center chest. The shoulder is defined as the visible part of the shoulder on the front of the shirt. There must be no more than five advertisements in total and National flags or emblems for the purpose of this regulation count as advertisements. Each advertisement, including National flags or emblems, must be 20 square centimeters or less.

Advertising contained in a band of uniform width not exceeding 10 centimeters on the front and not exceeding five centimeters on the backs. Such a band may be at any angle and may be on the front of the shirt, the back of the shirt, or both. $[\underline{sep}]$

Other Clothing

Each sock may carry two advertisements of 20 square centimeters or less.

Advertising on shoes is accepted subject to the make and model of shoe being available in the open market for at least three months prior to the tournament in which they are being worn. $\left[\underbrace{sep} \right]$









Each other article of clothing may carry one advertisement of 20 square centimeters or less. $\begin{bmatrix} L \\ SEP \end{bmatrix}$

Clothing worn under player shirts, shorts, skirts or dresses, shall be known as 'underclothing' and not categorized as 'articles of clothing', and if visible must not display advertising. [sep]

Restrictions on the advertising

The advertisements in Regulations 23.2 and 23.3 may be the clothing manufacturer's [1] emblem or that of any sponsor. [2]

Each advertisement shall only be of one organization or product.

The advertisements shall follow the International Olympic Committee principles and shall not contain any political, religious messages or anything which is not a commercial brand, registered mark or trade mark. (e.g. I don't have a sponsor, I am nice, etc.).

Players displaying tattoos, paints, transfers or similar (which are not on clothing) may not display any tattoo, paint or transfer which is illegal, defamatory or commercial in nature or otherwise in breach of the principles relating to advertising on clothing outlined in 23.4.3 $\frac{1}{25}$

Member Association advertising

Member Associations may use an area not exceeding fifty square centimeters on their players' shorts or lower part of dresses or skirts.
