The tournament will be played in full accordance with the Laws of Badminton (see <http://www.bwfbadminton.org>), the Competition Regulations (see <http://www.bwfbadminton.org>), and the tournament is also played according to the Badminton Europe Junior Circuit Regulations 2017.

In the event of any dispute, the Referee's decision shall be final.

Tournament Dates : 1st March – 5th March 2017.

Schedule : **This is a preliminary schedule and is subject to changes, based on number of registrations.**

Wednesday 1st March : MS R 128, WD R 64 and MxD R 64.

Thursday 2nd March : MS R 64, WS R 64, MD R 64 and WD R 32.

Friday 3rd March : MS R 32, WS R 32, MD R 32, MxD R 32 and MxD R 16.

Saturday 4th March : MS R 16, WS R 16, MD R 16, WD R 16, all events ¼ finals and MxD ½ finals.

Sunday 5th March : ½ finals MS-WS-MD-WD and all finals.

Expected playtime Tuesday-Saturday: 09:30-22:00, Sunday: 10:00-16:00.



Entry closing date :

- a. Entries closing date Tuesday 31st of January 2017 - 23.59 hours BWF headquarters time, (+ 08:00 GMT).
- b. After the closing date, the BWF Online Entry System will send a notification confirming reception of final entries to all participating Member Associations. Receipt of this notification is the conclusive evidence of reception of entries before the deadline.
- c. The online entry page will close immediately at the time stated above. Late entries will not be accepted.

Entries :

- a. Competitors must be members of clubs belonging to an organisation in membership with the BWF. **Participation is restricted to players born in 1999 or later.** (This is the same age limit as used by the German Junior).
- b. The maximum amount of competitors (players/pairs) accepted in the tournament is MS 96, WS 64, MD and WD 48, and MxD 64.
- c. If the amount of entries exceeds the maximum amount as listed above in section b, a selection of entries will be made in the following order:
 - i. Points on the BWF Junior Ranking.
 - ii. Foreign players without points on the BWF Junior Ranking, drawn by lots (no country can have two players/pairs without points participating before all entered countries have at least one player/pair without points participating).
 - iii. Home nation players in order of strength as listed by their Member Association.
 - iv. The selection of entries shall be done by BADMINTON EUROPE.
- d. Entries must be done in order of strength.
- e. All entries must be made by using the BWF Online Entry System:

- f. Competitors and officials who need visa for the Netherlands should send an **application for visa not later than 11 January 2017**, to the Tournament Committee. **We cannot accept entries needing visa without such an application.**
- g. Entry fees are € 28,00 per competitor for the singles and € 38,00 per pair for the doubles. The Member Association that enters a player/pair into a BEC Junior Circuit tournament is



responsible for paying the entry fees for that player/pair. The entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn when the entry deadline passes.

Payment can be done prior to the start of the tournament by bank transfer according to payment instructions provided by email after registration.

At the venue, cash payment of all fees due is possible before the start of the tournament. For cash payment an additional administrative fee of € 10,00 per payment is applicable.

h. When none of the events has at least 8 competitors, the tournament is cancelled.

i. It is required that every event in a particular Junior Circuit tournament has at least 8 competitors (i.e. actual competitors, not merely entries). If the required number of competitors is not met, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.

j. BADMINTON EUROPE nor Badminton Nederland nor BC Duijwijck is liable for any costs incurred by third persons (players, coaches, umpires, team managers etc.) because of an event not having enough competitors to count for the rankings.

Seeding and drawing

Seeding will be done by Badminton Europe. The draw will be made by Badminton Europe on Tuesday 14 February 2017.

System of play

All events will be played according to a knockout system.

Match conditions

a. Competitors must be prepared to play 15 minutes before scheduled time. No exception will be made to this rule.

b. Yonex Aerosensa 50 shuttlecocks will be used exclusively. Shuttles will be free of charge.

c. An umpire will be appointed for each match.

d. During the tournament, a physiotherapist will be available for the competitors, free of charge.

e. For the tournament 4 courts are available.

Clothing and advertising

Clothing worn by players during play has to be acceptable badminton sports clothing. Each article of clothing may be of any colour or combinations of colours.

Players in semifinals and finals in MD, WD and MxD should wear the same colour of shirt and short or skirt.

Colour, design, lettering and advertising on clothing shall be regulated by BWF General Competition Regulations 19 to 23. The name on the back of the shirt is optional.
