After the closing date, the BWF Online Entry System will send notification to all participating Member Associations confirming receipt of final entries. Receipt of this notification is the conclusive evidence of receipt of entries before the deadline.

The Member Associations should contact BWF immediately if such notice is not received by the Wednesday (next day of the entries closing date) by noon BWF Headquarters time (+08.00h GMT) following close of entries.

If no objection is received by BWF by Thursday (second day after the entries closing day) 23.59 hours BWF Headquarters time (+08.00h GMT) following the close of entries, the entries shall be deemed to be correct. No complaints / objections shall be entertained after this point.

Managers Meeting: A Managers Meeting will be held at the competition venue at **9:00 am, Thursday 31th August** (may be subject to change if necessary).

All countries are to ensure they have a representative at this meeting
It is compulsory that all team managers attend the team managers meeting. Failing to attend the meeting, a Member Association may be fined USD\$250 by Badminton Oceania. Member Associations can make a request for someone to represent them at the meeting on condition the Referee is advised in advance.

Competition Rules and Regulations: The tournament will be conducted in accordance with the BWF General Competition Regulations.

Shuttles: BWF approved shuttles will be used – 2 speeds will be available. Details will be advised at the Managers Meeting.

Clothing & Advertising: Clothing and advertising must be in accordance with the BWF General Competition Regulations (sections 19-23). Whilst the name of the player is mandatory on the back of all players' shirts, the country name is optional. Players should ensure they read these regulations prior to the event to ensure their clothing complies.
