	The tournament will be played in full accordance with the laws of Badminton and
Conditions of play	Competition Regulations adopted by the BWF as well as the regulations of the
	Badminton Europe's Circuit.
	(c)If more players/pairs enter the competition than the Organisers can accept the
	BWF Junior Ranking shall be used to determine the players/pairs whose entries can be
	accepted and which entry to fill any subsequent vacancy that may arise.
	Competitors must be prepared to play at the times quoted in the order of play for the
	events for which they were entered.
	Competitors can be scratched if not ready to play when called.

Clothing / Advertising	Players shall not plan their departure less than two (2) hours after their last match is planned to conclude. If a player/pair is unable to compete due to early departure, such a player/pair shall lose all the Circuit Ranking points gained at the particular tournament and BADMINTON EUROPE shall propose to BWF that the gained BWF ranking points are also removed. (Regulation 9.5 in Badminton Europe's Circuit regulations). The seeding's and the draw will be done by Badminton Europe. Clothing and advertising will be permitted in accordance with the regulations of the BWF (Competition Regulations 19-23)

	Singles: €25 per player Doubles €20 per player per event
	The Member Association that enters a player into a Circuit tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player.
	The entry fees must be paid at the same times as the entries are submitted. The entry fees will not be refunded in the event of a withdrawal once the entry deadline has passed.
	Organisers are allowed to refuse entries if players have outstanding fees from a previous year.
Visas	After entering player(s) in the tournament it is the Member Association's responsibility to secure visas for their players – if this is needed. It is the Member Association's responsibility to make sure that visa applications are made early enough.

	The Tournament Organisers will do everything possible to enable the entered players to get a visa.
	There are two tournament hotels for players to choose from:
Accommodation	1: Metro Hotel - http://www.metrohoteldublinairport.com/
	2: Travel Lodge South - https://www.travelodge.ie/hotels/378/Dublin-Airport-South- hotel
	Both hotels are within 15 minutes from the hall and will be have regular transport to the venue. Players staying in any other hotel or accommodation must make their own way to the venue.
	It is players own responsibility to book their accommodation. This can be done by contacting the hotel directly. Hotel availability and prices can be unpredictable so it is highly advised that you book your accommodation as soon as possible to avoid disappointment.
	Badminton Ireland does not have any special rates or reserved rooms with either hotel.
	Airport: Transport will be provided from Dublin Airport to those using the tournament Hotels. Available from hotel shuttle bus at the below times.
	Metro - Between 4am and 11:30pm, 7 days a week.
<u>_</u>	Travel Lodge - 5am to 9am and 5pm to 9pm.
Transport	Hotel: Transport will be provided between Tournament Hotels and Baldoyle BC only. Available for the duration of the event. Note : There is limited or no public transport between the hotels and the venue, transport will be provided regularly between the hall and the tournament hotels.
Insurance	Any special medical treatment necessary or hospitalization due to serious illness or injury is at the players or officials own expense.
Medical	A physiotherapist will be present in the Sports hall during the tournament and a medical doctor will be on call.
Managers Meeting	There will be a Managers meeting at 20:00 in the Metro on Thursday 1st September. If further meetings are required, they will be advised in due course.
