Entry fees

Singles: 25 € per player

Doubles: 20 € per player per event

The Member Association that enters a player/pair into a BE Junior circuit tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player/pair. The entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn by the Member Association by midnight local time on the closing date. The entry fees must be paid before the first scheduled match, failure to do so means that you will not be allowed to play.

Accommodations

Meals

Warm meals could be taken at the hall. The price for a meal is 10 €. Please use the form.

Invoicing

and meals ordered will be sent to you before the tournament. The invoice must be paid at the tournament before the first scheduled match, failure to do so means that you will not be allowed to play.

Condition of play

The tournament will be played in full accordance with the Laws of Badminton and the Competition Regulations adopted by the BWF as well as the Junior Circuit Regulations. Competitors must be prepared to play at the times determined for the events for which they have entered. Competitors will be scratched if not ready to play when called.

A physiotherapist will be present in the Sports hall during the tournament.

Drug testing

According to Belgian law drug testing may be carried out on a random basis at any time.

Advertising on clothing and colour of clothing shall be regulated by BWF Competition Regulations 19 to 23. In the event of any dispute, the Referee's decision shall be final.
