8. Scoring system: **Experimental scoring system will be used in the tournament - the best of five games of 11 points.**

A match shall consist of the best of five games; a game shall be won by the side which first scores 11 points, except as provided in Law 7.3 and 7.4. If the score becomes 10-all, the side which gains a two point lead first, shall win the game. If the score becomes 14-all, the side scoring the 15th point shall win the game.

For those who require the invitation letter for visa purpose must submit the completed visa form to beatrixw7@gmail.com by **19th September 2016**.
You must apply for your visa at least 15 working days before it is needed, to allow time for your application to be processed.
Please note the letter of invitation we provide does not guarantee entry into Chinese Taipei and the final decision is made by the Taipei Representative Office in your country. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that they apply for their visa in sufficient time. Any issues with the visa application need to be dealt with directly to

the Embassy who is dealing with your application.

We accept no responsibility for withdrawals made due to late visa applications. Where required, courier costs to post letters of invitation will be recharged to your association.

For players and team officials holding passports of People's Republic of China, please start your visa application at least 45 working days to ensure you can receive the visa in time.

23. Press Interview:

Players must attend the interview after their respective matches and any other request time (eg. Press conference, training session, etc) whenever necessary.

24. Accreditation:

Please complete and return the accreditation form together with a jpg head and shoulders photo of all members in your team by **19th September**. It requires accreditation to enter the stadium, so please carry your accreditation with you at all time and make sure to contact our reception staff for your accreditation. The number of team officials and coaches accreditation passes issued to each team is dependent upon the size of your team.

Accreditation policy is as below.
