Clothing:	 Color, design, lettering and advertising on players' clothing shall be regulated by General Competition Regulations 19 to 23. For International Challenge tournaments, the name on the back of the shirt is mandatory for all matches in the main draw. It is mandatory for the semi-finals and finals that partners in doubles wear the same color. In applying General Competition Regulations 19 to 23, the decision of the Referee shall be final.
