IVORY COAST JUNIOR INTERNATIONAL 2017

On behalf of the **Fédération Ivoirienne de Badminton (FIBad)**, we have the pleasure to invite your Association to participate in the Ivory Coast Junior International 2017 (Junior Future Series) which will be held from Thursday 23rd to 25th June 2017 in Abidjan. VISA	Application for visa must be made to the Côte d'Ivoire Embassy in your country. Support letter will be provided upon request from your association. For those who do not have Côte d'Ivoire embassy in their country, visas can be obtained on arrival at the Abidjan International Airport. The visa procedures will cost US\$ 66 per visa and must be paid to FIBad upon arrival. Players and Official are requested to send all relevant documents (Passport Copy, Air Ticket, etc) to FIBad by 1 June 2017 for visa on arrival.

WITHDRAWALS	<p>Withdrawal of players without penalty is Sunday 4 June 2017. Players withdrawing after Sunday 4 June 2017 or no-show will have to pay a fine of US\$ 150 and US\$ 500 respectively.</p>																										



INSURANCE	Participants must arrange their own insurance for health, travel and property. The organisers will not be responsible for any medical costs.
CONDITIONS	<p>The tournament will be played on a knock-out system and in full accordance with the General Competition Regulations of the BWF and the instructions of Badminton Confederation Africa. Competitors must be prepared to play at the times determined for the events for which they have entered.</p> <p>Players shall not plan their departure less than four (4) hours after their last match is plan to conclude. Such a player/pair shall lose all the ranking points gained and Badminton Confederation Africa shall propose to BWF that the gained BWF ranking points are removed.</p> <p>According to the BWF General Competition Regulations, there is no world ranking points for an International with less than 8 entries in (MS, WS, MD, WD and XD). In such a case, the tournament may be cancelled and the organisers will not take any responsibility for any arrangements that may have been already made.</p>
