 - Receipt of this notification is the conclusive evidence of receipt of entries before the deadline. The Member Associations should contact BWF immediately if such notice is not received by Wednesday July 5, 2017 12:00 noon BWF Headquarters time following close of entries.
 - If no objection is received by BWF by Thursday July 6, 2017 23.59 hours BWF Headquarters time following the close of entries, the entries shall be deemed correct. No complaints / objections shall be entertained after this point.

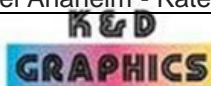
Withdrawals:

Betting is however not allowed to be made by players or officials connected to the event either in person or through a third party. Participants may therefore not make bets on the Event or procure through third parties the making of bets with a betting agency. • Participants who, in violation of this prohibition, nevertheless make or procure through third parties the making of bets with betting agencies shall be immediately disqualified from participation in the Event and are liable for legal prosecution. Similarly, manipulation of games will be met with disqualification and possible legal prosecution. Any violation mentioned above is also a breach of Player’s Code of Conduct (Art. 5.2.) and will be sanctioned by BWF.”
Clothing:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Color, design, lettering and advertising on players’ clothing shall be regulated by General Competition Regulations 19 to 23. • For International Series tournaments, the name on the back of the shirt is mandatory for all matches in the main draw. • It is mandatory for the semi-finals and finals that partners in doubles wear the same color. • In applying General Competition Regulations 19 to 23, the decision of the Referee shall be final.
