Regulation	<p>It is required that every event in a particular BEC Junior Circuit tournament has at least 8 competitors (i.e.. actual competitors, not merely entries). If the required number of competitors is not met, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.</p> <p>In accordance with regulation 10.4 in Appendix 6 to BWF's General Competition Regulations, an event must contain at least one entry from a Member Association other than the hosting Association. If an event does not contain at least one entry from a Member Association other than the hosting Association, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.</p> <p>BADMINTON EUROPE is not liable for any costs incurred by third persons (players, coaches, umpires, team managers etc.) because of an event not having enough competitors to count for the rankings.</p>
Events	Men's and Women's Singles Men's and Women's Doubles Mixed Doubles Entry Limits: MS64, WS64, MD32, WD32, XD48
Eligible Players	All players of clubs affiliated through their National Associations to the BWF. Competitors can be scratched if not ready to play when called. The seeding's and the draw will be done by Badminton Europe.

Conditions of play	<p>The tournament will be played in full accordance with the laws of Badminton and Competition Regulations adopted by the BWF as well as the regulations of the Badminton Europe's Circuit.</p> <p>(c) If more players/pairs enter the competition than the Organisers can accept the BWF Junior Ranking shall be used to determine the players/pairs whose entries can be accepted and which entry to fill any subsequent vacancy that may arise. Competitors must be prepared to play at the times quoted in the order of play for the events for which they were entered. Competitors can be scratched if not ready to play when called. Players shall not plan their departure less than two (2) hours after their last match is planned to conclude. *Finals may not conclude until 4 P.M</p> <p>The seeding's and the draw will be done by Badminton Europe.</p> <p>A withdrawal (after the draw is made), a "No Show" or the retirement of a player in any event will cause that player to be withdrawn from all entered events.</p>
Clothing / Advertising	<p>Clothing and advertising will be permitted in accordance with the regulations of the BWF(Competition Regulations 19-23) and BEC Junior Circuit Reg. 13</p> <p>13.1 Colour, design, lettering and advertising on clothing shall be regulated by BWF General Competition Regulations 19 to 23. A player violating these regulations shall be penalized by an administrative fine of 50,00 EUR.</p> <p>13.2 For all BEC Junior Circuit tournaments the name on the back of the shirts is mandatory at all time during play in the semi-finals and finals A player failing to wear the name on his/her shirt when mandatory shall result in an administrative fine of 50,00 EUR.</p> <p>13.3 It is mandatory for the semi-finals and finals that partners in doubles wear the same colour of the T-shirt and shorts/skirts. Failing to do so shall result in an administrative fine of 50,00 EUR.</p>

	The Member Association that enters a player/pair into a BEC Junior Circuit tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player/pair. The entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn when the entry deadline passes. It is recommended that the entry fees are paid by bank transfer, but the Organisers can accept cash payments at tournaments.
Visas	After entering player(s) in the tournament it is the Member Association's responsibility to secure visas for their players – if this is needed. It is the Member Association's responsibility to make sure that visa applications are made early enough. The Tournament Organisers will do everything possible to enable the entered players to get a visa.
