

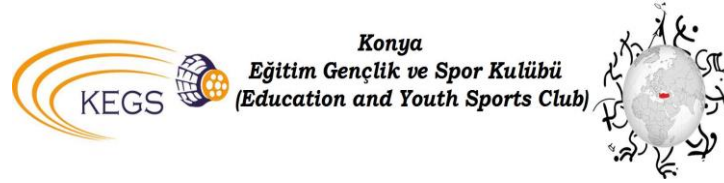

- **€ 90 per person** (athlete, coach, official, physiotherapist, accompanying person)
- Entry fees are **non-refundable** once paid and if the person does not attend the competition. Fees are only refunded if there not enough entries to have a competition.
- Entry fees includes accreditation, water and a variety of gifts.

## Part III - Regulations

The competition will be organised and run in accordance with the Classification Regulations, Para-Badminton Regulations, General Competition Regulations and Laws of Badminton. The below are a few reminders of important regulations. Please see the BWF website for the full details.

<b>Minimum Entries</b>	If entries are not sufficient for a group draw followed by a knock-out draw, a single group format shall apply.
<b>Combinations</b>	If there are less than four (4) entries or less than three (3) represented countries in a particular event, the events may be combined in accordance with the Para-Badminton Competition Regulation 9.1.5 – see <a href="http://www.bwfbadminton.com">www.bwfbadminton.com</a>
<b>Withdrawals</b>	<p>All withdrawals should be confirmed to the Referee, TD and Tournament Organiser in writing as soon as possible – at least 7 days before first competition day. Technical Delegate can be contacted via: <a href="mailto:entries@bwfbadminton.org">entries@bwfbadminton.org</a></p> <p>Penalties may apply to withdrawals received within 7 days of the first competition day. Any withdrawal must be accompanied by the appropriate certification</p>
<b>Conditions of play</b>	The tournament will be played in accordance with BWF Laws of Badminton and Para-Badminton Competition Regulations – see the BWF website <a href="http://bwfcorporate.com/regulations/">http://bwfcorporate.com/regulations/</a>

<b>Readiness to Play</b>	All events will be run on a strict time scale. <u>Competitors must be ready to play 30 minutes before the scheduled match time.</u> If players are not ready to play at the scheduled time they will be disqualified. Any changes to the schedule of play will be announced by the Referee.
<b>Warm-up / practicing</b>	On court, warm up time is limited to a maximum of 2 minutes.
<b>Entry</b>	Entries can only be accepted on the Official Entry Form.
<b>Modifications</b>	In case of modifications or to give the Organisers additional information - <b>write these on the Official Entry Form and resend this by email.</b>
<b>Acceptance of entries</b>	Entries can only be accepted from BWF Members and a national or regional Para-Badminton organisation recognised by the BWF.
<b>Request for Partner</b>	<p>A registration for doubles can only be accepted with the name of the partner / pair or with "partner wanted" on the form if a partner is being requested.</p> <p>Any mix nationality pairings, must be entered and approved by both represented countries.</p> <p>If confirmation is not received by both countries, the entry will not be accepted</p>
<b>Clothing &amp; Advertising</b>	<p>See clothing Regulations          Para-Badminton Competition Regulations 15, 16, 17.          General Competition Regulations 19, 20, 21, 22, 23</p> <p><b>Note: Clothing regulations will strictly be adhered at this event. Failure to comply may affect an athlete's eligibility to go on court and compete.</b></p>
<b>Awards</b>	No matches will be played to determine 3rd/4th place.
<b>Prizes</b>	Prizes will be awarded in accordance with PBCR 3.3.2
<b>Doping control</b>	<p>Therapeutic Use Exemptions (TUE) – players who must take medications which contained Prohibited Substances, <b>MUST</b> seek permission to use these substances before they take these. TUE's <b>MUST</b> be approved 21 days before international competition.
