Minimum Entries

If there are less than four (4) entries or less than three (3) represented countries in a particular event, then events may be combined – Sport Classes and or men & women – in accordance with Para-Badminton Competition Regulation 5.1.5.1.

AUD 100 per person for athletes

AUD 75 per person for coach, team manager, official, physiotherapist or accompanying person.

Entry fees are **non-refundable** if the person does not attend the competition or is classified as NE. Fees are refunded if there are not enough entries to have a competition.

Entry Fee

Any accompanying person staying at the official accommodation must pay an entry fee. Without payment of the entry fee a person cannot use the services provided by the fee: accommodation including breakfast, ground transportation, lunch, and any other additional services the event may provide.

Lunch will be provided every day at the venue from Monday 26 November – Sunday 27 November, for all people who have paid an entry fee. Lunch will be a “typical Australian” lunch (filled roll or sandwich, muffin, fruit).

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| <p>Accommodation</p> | <p>Deakin University, Geelong Waterfront (1 Gheringhap St, Geelong VIC 3220) * 8km from the competition venue * 21km from Avalon Airport (GEL) * 81km from Melbourne Airport (MEL)</p> <p>AUD 200 for players who played in the Australia Para-Badminton International and stayed at the official accommodation (ie. Have paid up until Monday 26 November) – per Single Room in a Shared Apartment. Departure Wednesday 28 November.</p> <p>AUD 400 for players who <u>did not play</u> in the Australia Para-Badminton International – per Single Room in a Shared Apartment. Arrival Saturday 24 November, Departure Wednesday 28 November.</p> <p>The arrival date may be later or the departure date may be earlier however the rate remains the same.</p> <p>Rates</p> <p>Each person has a private bedroom and share a fully equipped kitchen, spacious living and dining room, and bathrooms with other housemates. Apartments range from 6 to 8 bedrooms. The competition will be organised and run in accordance with the Classification Regulations, Para-Badminton Regulations, General Competition Regulations and Laws of Badminton. The below are a few reminders of important regulations. Please see the BWF website for the full details.

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| Minimum Entries | If entries are not sufficient for a group draw followed by a knock-out draw, a single group format shall apply. |
| Combinations | If there are less than four (4) entries or less than three (3) represented countries in a particular event, the events may be combined in accordance with the Para-Badminton Competition Regulation 9.1.5 – see: bwfcorporate.com/statutes/ |
| Withdrawals | <p>All withdrawals should be confirmed to the Referee, TD and Tournament Organiser in writing as soon as possible – at least 7 days before first competition day.</p> <p>Technical Delegate: entries@bwfbadminton.org</p> <p>Penalties may apply to withdrawals received within 7 days of the first competition day. Any withdrawal must be accompanied by the appropriate certification</p> |
| Conditions of play | The tournament will be played in accordance with BWF Laws of Badminton and Para-Badminton Competition Regulations – see the BWF website http://bwfcorporate.com/statutes/ |
| Readiness to Play | All events will be run on a strict time scale. <u>Competitors must be ready to play 30 minutes before the scheduled match time.</u> If players are not ready to play at the scheduled time they will be disqualified. Any changes to the schedule of play will be announced by the Referee. |
| Warm-up / practicing | On court, warm up time is limited to a maximum of 2 minutes. |
| Entry | Entries can only be accepted on the Official Entry Form. |
| Modifications | In case of modifications or to give the Organisers additional information - write these on the Official Entry Form and resend this by email. |
| Acceptance of entries | Entries can only be accepted from BWF Members and a national or regional Para-Badminton organisation recognised by the BWF. |
| Request for Partner | <p>A registration for doubles can only be accepted with the name of the partner / pair or with “partner wanted” on the form if a partner is being requested.</p> <p>Any mixed nationality pairings, must be entered and approved by both represented countries.</p> <p>If confirmation is not received by both countries, the entry will not be accepted</p> |
| Clothing & Advertising | <p>See clothing Regulations Para-Badminton Competition Regulations 15, 16, 17. General Competition Regulations 19, 20, 21, 22, 23</p> <p>Note: Clothing regulations should be adhered at this event. Failure to comply may affect an athlete’s eligibility to go on court and compete.</p> |
| Awards | No matches will be played to determine 3rd/4th place. |
| Medals | Medals will be awarded in accordance with PBGCR 3.3 |
| Doping control | Therapeutic Use Exemptions (TUE) – players who must take medications which contained Prohibited Substances, MUST seek permission to use these substances before they take these. TUE’s MUST be approved 21 days before international competition. The forms are available on the BWF website (link) |

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| Eligibility | <p>Any new player wishing to participate in this tournament will need to be classified according to the BWF Para-Badminton Classification Regulations.</p> <p>Players with a Sport Class Status New (New), R (Review), FRD (Fixed Review Date) or CNC (Classification Not Complete) must take part in Classification / Player Evaluation at the tournament.</p> <p>The medical forms for players with Sport Class Status N, R, FRD or CNC must be submitted together with the entries and should be emailed to classification@bwfbadminton.org</p> <p>Player Medical Information Form and Player Evaluation Consent Form can be downloaded from the BWF website (link)</p> <p>Please submit your forms by: Tuesday 2 October 2018 (11:59 PM Kuala Lumpur time).</p> <p>You must confirm with the Chief Classifier of your document submission.
